Swiss Business Intelligence Hub: The program hosts a blog to enable free exchange of relevant information among program and discipline participants. It serves to learn about and record some of the numerous helpful conversations going on around social-science statistics. See <http://businessintelligencehub.org>.

The R Enterprise Network application: RDS hosts a publicly available installation of the Enterprise Network software, an open-source data sharing and analyzing web application developed and maintained by the Enterprise Network Project at the RDS. Each Enterprise Network installation consists of individual databases, or virtual clusters, for storing, processing, distributing and sharing data (uploading data to this application helps ensure that a cluster's initial virtual cluster doesn't become obsolete for storage, and increases web visibility). RCE: The Research-Computing Environment (RCE) supplies a persistent desktop environment that is accessible from any computer with an Internet connection. It offers a centralized place to access to more data, test analyses, and collaborate with other researchers. Access is provided to numerous statistical analysis packages, including R, GAUSS, Mathematica, MATLAB, RStudio, SAS, S-Plus, Stata, and SPSS. To request use of these tools for large-scale virtual clusters, the RCE includes multiple choice computing requests. See <http://www.r-project.org/projects/rce/index.html>.

shdlib: The program facilitates collaborative on-demand off-site package use with "hosted R". This shared program can be run by any member of a collaborative team to maintain package security automatically for all users' interests, use, providing an ideal coordination tool, compiling and publishing updated documentation for the latest package, and sending the package to the CRAN repository.
